

**TRANSIT, PARKING AND TRAFFIC COMMITTEE**  
**MEETING MINUTES**

**Approval of Last Meeting's Minutes:**   Mikey King made a motion to approve the minutes from February 23, 2017 as written.   The motion was seconded by Felisha Perrodin.   Motion carried unanimously.

**Report on Current Status of Transit and Parking:**

1. The kick-off conference call for the LPR system is tomorrow.
2. We visited Sam Houston State (SHS) and Florida International University (FIU) last week.
  - a. SHS has been using NuPark for about two years and uses a zone system for lot assignments.
  - b. Has 22,000 students and 7,600 parking spaces.
  - c. They allow students to register two vehicles and faculty and staff to register four vehicles
  - d. Their parking garage enforces itself with LPR cameras and pay-by plate meters.
  - e. FIU has 54,000 students and 16,500 spaces. (We have 27,000 students and 13,500 spaces.)
  - f. Can register one vehicle. Charge \$15 to register up to four vehicles.
  - g. Charge \$100 for having more than one vehicle on campus at the same time.
  - h. Have auto renewal of virtual permits.
  - i. Parking link can be added to event webpages to allow participants to purchase parking for the event.
  - j. Departments can purchase virtual permits for their guests.
3. Phi Mu construction starts next week. Lot 38A, a gravel Faculty/Staff lot on the corner of Maple and Leverett, will be closed at that time. They want the south section of lot 38 for staging but can wait until after commencement to close it.
4. Alpha Chi Omega construction will begin in July. This project will close lots 32, 33 and 33A. We will have recommendations for lot redesignations at the next TPT meeting.
5. Delta Gamma will begin construction late fall/early winter.

6. Razorback Road/SH 112 project still not out for bids.
7. Stadium Drive, between Meadow and Clinton, will close after the Walmart shareholders meeting until early August.
8. Working on building lot 68, a 40-space gravel lot on the northeast corner of Maple and Storer.

**Old Business:**

Laura Shiver made a motion to increase the following citation fees effective 7/1/17:

- Unauthorized parking in or blocking of a disabled person parking space or access aisle from \$150 to \$200;
- Parking on University of Arkansas property without permit from \$40 to \$50.

The motion was seconded by Cindy Morley. Motion carried unanimously.

Chris Shields made a motion to create a new violation and fee effective 7/1/17:

- No Overnight Parking - \$75

Laura Shiver seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously.

**New Business:**

Matt Trantham made a motion to approve the 3% across the board permit fee increase (except for faculty/staff making under \$40,000/year) effective 7/1/17. The motion was seconded by Cindy Morley. The motion carried with Felisha Perrodin abstaining.

A request by a non-university person that lot 15A be designated as a 24-hour lot was discussed. A decision was made that this person should work with the City for their assistance with their issue.

Matt Trantham made a motion to adjourn the meeting. The motion was seconded by Cindy Morley. Motion carried unanimously. Meeting adjourned at 2:50 pm.
