

**University of Arkansas, Transit and Parking, Razorback Transit  
Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) Policy Notice**

It is the policy of Razorback Transit that small businesses owned and managed by socially and economically disadvantaged individuals, as defined by the Disadvantaged Business Enterprise rule in Title 49 Code Federal Regulations Part 26, shall have the maximum opportunity to participate in the performance of public contracts financed in whole, or in part, by the Federal Transit Administration. It is also our policy to ensure that disadvantaged businesses are afforded equal opportunities. Razorback Transit has established overall program goals for the universities' fiscal years of 2012-2014. Specifically, Razorback Transit proposes to award a minimum of 0.5848% of the federal assistance it receives in public contracting opportunities to Arkansas Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) certified DBEs, <http://www.arkansashighways.com/dbe/dbe.aspx>. Overall goals are available for inspection by the public for 30 days following the publication of this notice; comments will be accepted for 45 days.
