

## **TRANSIT, PARKING AND TRAFFIC COMMITTEE ANNUAL REPORT – FY20**

The Transit, Parking and Traffic Committee met five times in Fiscal Year 2020: September 24, October 29, January 28, April 29 and May 20.

Items of business that were approved this year:

October 29, 2019

1. Changing garage assignment priority beginning fall 2021: faculty/staff, followed by resident students that did not get a resident reserved permit, followed by graduate students, followed by seniors, juniors, sophomores, and freshman.
2. Approved the electric vehicle charging station costs and rules.
3. Approved the e-scooter rules with the addition of no cell phones or headphones in use while operating an e-scooter.

January 28, 2020

4. Redesignate lot 46W from a faculty/staff parking lot to a student parking lot with no overnight parking.
5. Change the wording on appeals to state business days instead of class days (when the university is open for business) beginning July 1, 2020.
6. Lot 62 ramp to the Bud Walton Arena designated as faculty/staff parking at all times effective February 7, 2020.
7. Increase the following violation fees effective July 1, 2020: (Note: Board of Trustees did not approve fee increases due to COVID-19 pandemic.)

Parked in or blocking fire lane	\$50 to \$75
No permit displayed	\$55 to \$75
Unauthorized parking space	\$55 to \$75
Parked or driving on grass	\$30 to \$40
Prohibited by sign	\$25 to \$35
Parked on yellow line or curb	\$25 to \$35
Disregard stall lines/wheel stop	\$25 to \$50
Expired parking meter	\$25 to \$30
Undesignated area	\$20 to \$25
Athletics prohibited by sign	\$100 to \$125
8. Beginning July 1, 2020, the violation fee will double after the third time for the same violation in a fiscal year. (Note: Board of Trustees did not approve fee increases due to COVID-19 pandemic.)

April 29, 2020

9. Lot 51 “no parking” area will be redesignated as faculty/staff parking beginning this summer (5-6 parking spaces).

10. Revise the athletic event notification process as well as modifying the new notification as needed.
11. Lots 56B and 46E will be “cleared” lots for use during women’s basketball games beginning this fall.

May 20, 2020

12. Metered parking in the Harmon Avenue Parking Garage will be moved from levels 8 and 9 to levels 1 and 2 beginning with the fall semester.
