

TRANSIT, PARKING AND TRAFFIC COMMITTEE ANNUAL REPORT – FY21

The Transit, Parking and Traffic Committee met three times in Fiscal Year 2021: October 26, 2020 (via email), March 2, 2021 and May 4, 2021.

Items of business that were approved this year:

October 26, 2020 (via email)

1. The appeal deadline changed from seven calendar days to 14 calendar days.

March 2, 2021

2. The parking regulations changed to allow faculty/staff to register four vehicles and students to register two vehicles for License Plate Recognition (LPR). This can be changed on a case-by-case basis and will be revisited in the fall of 2021 or before.
3. Additional signage will not be placed in permitted lots stating plate must face drive lane.
4. The plate must face drive lane violation will be improper parking with a \$25 violation fee (an already existing violation).
5. Lot 44 will not become a Flowbird (metered) lot. This can be revisited at a later date.
6. Single space short term “gold” meters will not be allowed to accept credit cards.

May 4, 2021

7. There is an additional option for accessible parking permit approval through OEOC.
8. Lot 15 and lot 15A will not be redesignated from faculty/staff parking to reserved parking.
