

TRANSIT, PARKING AND TRAFFIC COMMITTEE ANNUAL REPORT – FY22

The Transit, Parking and Traffic Committee met five times in Fiscal Year 2022: September 28, 2021, November 22, 2021, January 24, 2022, March 29, 2022, and April 28, 2022.

Items of business that were approved this year:

September 28, 2021 (via email)

1. The electric charging fee for current garage permit holders was reduced to \$1.00/hour for electricity and charging station use only.
2. Overnight electric vehicle charging in HAPG and GAPG is allowed.
3. Athletics using lots 73A, 74, 74A, 74B, 74C and 74D for basketball priority parking effective November 2021 is allowed.

November 22, 2021

4. A Garth Brooks concert will be held in Donald W. Reynolds Razorback Stadium on April 23, 2022. The parking lots will be cleared, and traffic will be controlled for the concert the same as for a home football game.
5. Felisha Perrodin was elected chair off the committee for this year.

January 24, 2022

6. Athletics will host a ReWired Event in the Bud Walton Arena (October 16-23, 2022) and the use of parking lot 60 beginning 5 pm on October 19-23, 2022, and parking lot 62 from October 16-23, 2022.
7. The commuter lot will be renamed the economy lot effective July 1, 2022.

March 29, 2022

8. Scooter parking spaces will be reduced in lots 37, 41, 48, 58 and 64 and changed to car parking spaces for resident reserved parking.
9. The starting date of resident reserved enforcement will change to after organized move-in.
10. Flowbird will be used in the 56 and 74 lots for summer parking only.

April 28, 2022

11. Some citations will be sent via email (no permit, unauthorized lot, meter violations) beginning next fiscal year.
12. A rule concerning timeline and appeals for the Work It Off Program beginning next fiscal year - 30 days from date of citation or 30 days from which the appeal is denied completing three hours of volunteering through the Volunteer Action Center.
