

**TRANSIT, PARKING AND TRAFFIC COMMITTEE MEETING  
APRIL 9, 2019      2:00 PM**

**Approval of Last Meeting's Minutes:** Felisha Perrodin made a motion to approve the minutes from January 25, 2019 as written. The motion was seconded by Karen Sebold. Motion carried unanimously.

**Report on Current Status of Transit and Parking:**

Leroy Pond Extension: extends Leroy Pond across Razorback Road. Waiting to determine funding availability. If the project is implemented, it should be completed before classes begin in August.

Stadium Drive work – completed - will be resurfaced in late summer 2020.

Razorback Road project - HWY 112 widening - completes work that started last summer. It widens Razorback Road to two lanes north bound and one lane southbound. Razorback Road, Meadow Street to Maple Street, and Maple Street, Razorback Road to Stadium Drive will be closed May 13 – early July. Maple Street, from Stadium Drive to Garland Avenue, will be closed early July to August 9.

Rose Hill Parking plan - expands parking between lots 10, 78, and Lot 78A and constructs lot 78B. These lots will be designated as Faculty/Staff. 130 spaces in lot 38 will be redesignated as Resident Reserved.

Student Success Center: constructs new ±70K SF south of Memorial Hall on the site of the existing School of Social Work. Lot 2 will be closed during this project and lot 68 will likely be used as construction office and laydown space.

Delta Gamma sorority is to be completed by July 1. When lot 14 reopens it will contain 40 Resident Reserved and 40 Faculty/Staff spaces.

Stadium Drive Residence Hall: Constructs 700 bed dormitory at Stadium Drive and Leroy Pond. The 130 space parking lot should open in October.

Google Transit is now available. It allows bus passengers to plan their route from origin to destination, using the various transit system in the area.

Passio Go!, which will replace campus map bus option, will be provided to the campus soon.

The Flowbird app, which replaced the Whoosh! app, is operational and will be advertised to the campus soon. It will have more options in the future - like being able to determine the number of metered spaces available in each location.

A new bus has been ordered for the Arkansas Research and Technology Park shuttle.

**Old Business:**

Jeremy McAtee made a motion to table the salary-based permit fees until more data and statistics can be researched. Karen Sebold seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously.

Jeremy McAtee made a motion to table parking for graduate students until more research is done. Samuel Lipson seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously.

**New Business:**

Jeremy McAtee made a motion to eliminate bicycle permits. Braxton Gately seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously.

Felisha Perrodin made a motion to redesignate resident reserved parking to reserved parking in lot 49 if Buchanan-Droke and Gladson-Ripley become office space and if there are sufficient requests to fill the lot. Braxton Gately seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously.

Felisha Perrodin made a motion to redesignate lot 46E as student parking (no overnight parking) and lot 46W as faculty/staff parking beginning fall semester if the Leroy Pond Extension project is complete. Chris Shields seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously.

Laura Shiver made a motion to leave lot 54 designated as faculty/staff parking. Samuel Lipson seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously.

Samuel Lipson made a motion to remove the no overnight restriction in lot 74. Felisha Perrodin seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously.

Braxton Gately made a motion to not change the designation of lot 37 and lot 42. Karen Sebold seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously.

Felisha Perrodin made a motion to revise the rules of the Work it Off Program to stipulate the \$50 can be used toward a higher priced citation beginning with the fall semester. Laura Shiver seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously.

Felisha Perrodin made a motion to table eliminating email notices for each athletic event until another option is available. Jeremy McAtee seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously.
