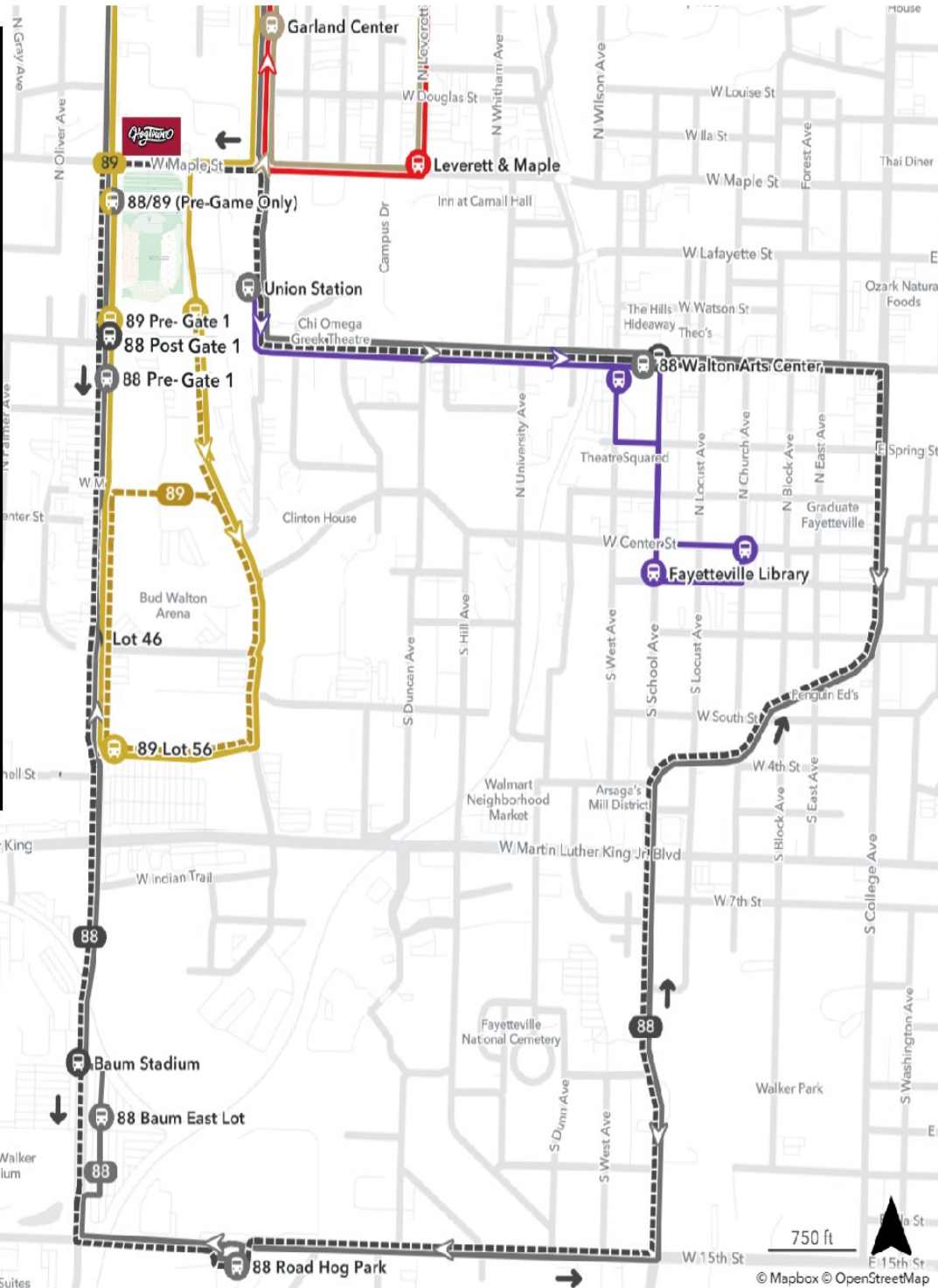

On Time Performance

A vehicle will be considered on time if it departs Union Station or the primary scheduled time point no more than 1 minute early or 5 minutes past the published schedule or time table. Razorback Transit recommends that passengers arrive at stops at least 5 minutes prior to the estimated time.

Razorback Transit provides ADA accessible, **fare-free fixed route and paratransit services** to the University of Arkansas and the General Public in the City of Fayetteville. Full Service operates Mon-Fri from 7AM until 6PM during the U of A academic year. Non-peak service is available Saturdays, summer, and breaks. There is no service on Sundays, University Holidays, or other days the University is closed. Due to weather, service may also be interrupted or cancelled.
